This Day in Engineering History

January 10, 1863 — London opened the first underground passenger railway to the public. The Metropolitan, also known as the Met, is a 41.4 mile long underground line that can reach speeds up to 60 mph. When the Met was first created the train consisted of wooden carriages and steam locomotives. The steam locomotives carried on to 1961 when the line was electrified.
