KSPE STEM Grant Report from Kansas City, KS Public Schools

We received a report from KC STEM Alliance on the grant KSPE gave KCK School District. The funds helped them expand their Project Lead The Way (PLTW) program – and hopefully recruit more students into STEM careers!

Project Lead The Way Launch provides transformative learning experiences for K-5 students and teachers across the U.S. Students participate in an engaging, hands-on classroom environment and are empowered to develop in-demand knowledge and skills needed to thrive. Project Lead the Way provides teachers with the training, resources, and support they need to engage students in real-world learning.

Through our grant, more than 2,628 students and teachers were impacted and participated. Grant funds were used to purchase PLTW kits and additional materials needed to continue and expand implementation of PLTW through the Library program.


